

Turf Application Schedule on a Bi-Monthly Basis

Step #	Month	Service
1.	Jan-Feb	Pre Emergent Post Emergent Potassium Application
2.	March-Apr	Pre Emergent Post Emergent Turf Fertilization-after green up
3.	May-June	Post Emergent Turf Fertilization Insecticide-as needed Fungicide-as needed
4.	July-Aug	Post Emergent Turf fertilization Insecticide-as needed Fungicide-as needed
5.	Sep-Oct	Pre Emergent (Please notify if you are over-seeding.) Post Emergent Turf Fertilization
6.	Nov-Dec	Post Emergent

- **Results of applications depend heavily upon cultural practices of the homeowner such as irrigation, de-thatching, core aeration, etc.**

- **Fire ant mounds will be treated during regular step at no additional cost.**
- **12 month fire ant prevention available at additional cost.**
- **Mole cricket and grub applications will be performed at no additional cost during regular step. If additional applications are necessary, then they will be billed at Plan I pricing.**
- **Flea and tick applications performed at additional cost.**
- **Core aeration will be performed at additional cost.**

2.	March-Apr	Pre Emergent Post Emergent Fertilization to turf & ornamentals-after green up Ornamental Fungicide & Insecticide Preventive Borer Spray to Dogwoods & Small Fruit Trees
3.	May-June	Turf Fertilization Turf Fungicide & Insecticide as needed Ornamental Fungicide & Insecticide
4.	July-Aug	Turf Fertilization Turf Fungicide & Insecticide as needed Ornamental Fungicide & Insecticide Post Emergent
5.	Sep-Oct	Pre Emergent (Please notify if you are over-seeding.) Fertilization Post Emergent
6.	Nov-Dec	Post Emergent Ornamental Oil Spray Lime Application

- Soil injection will be performed once per year depending on when you started your plan. The cost of this application is amortized over the year and no charge is made at time of application.
